STHK FLOWCHART FOR ELECTIVE INPATIENT AND DAY CASE ADMISSIONS FOR NON-CANCER SURGERY

Screening questions: Patients to be contacted more than 14 days before the planned surgery

- 1. Can you commence the process of self-isolation for you and everyone else in your household 14 days prior to the date of surgery?
- 2. Have you and all else in your household been free of any COVID symptoms (new onset continuous cough, fever and/or loss or change in your normal sense of smell or taste) in the last 14 days?

Answered YES to both: proceed to swab

Is the patient in the shielded category?

No

Yes

Inform patient they will be tested on day of admission: Continue shielding/self-isolation until the day of procedure

Answered **NO to either: do NOT proceed** (Discuss with clinical team if urgent)

- Arrange swab 48-72 hours before admission
- Once swabbed, patient must continue to self- isolate until results known. Patient to be informed of results by pre-op assessment staff (and advised accordingly)

Negative swab result: confirm can proceed to admission. Advise patient to self-isolate until date of admission and to contact the respective department if symptoms develop during that time.

<u>Positive</u> swab result: <u>do not</u> proceed to admission.

Patient and household must self- isolate as per DH guidance.

Discuss with clinical team if urgent.

Screening on the day of elective admission:

- 1. Has anyone in the household has had any COVID symptoms (new onset continuous cough or fever and/or loss or change in your normal sense of smell or taste) since you were swabbed?
- 2. Have you had any symptoms (new onset continuous cough or fever and/or loss or change in your normal sense of smell or taste) since you were swabbed?
- 3. Check patient's temperature

Answered <u>yes</u> to any questions <u>and/or temperature is 37.8°C or more:</u> do NOT admit

(Discuss with clinical team if urgent)

If answered <u>no</u> to all questions <u>and</u> temperature below 37.8°C and is a <u>shielded</u> patient: Order rapid COVID-19 test

If answered <u>no</u> to all questions and temperature below 37.8°C and <u>not</u> a shielded patient Proceed to admit for elective surgery into a 'clean' bay, (i.e. bay of elective admissions which have tested negative) or a cubicle

<u>Clinically urgent</u>: admit to a cubicle and liaise with microbiology to arrange a rapid COVID test (ext 1837 or on call microbiologist via switch for out of hours)

Negative rapid swab result

<u>Positive</u> rapid swab result: <u>do not</u> proceed to admission. Patient and household must self- isolate as per <u>DH</u> <u>guidance</u>. Discuss with clinical team if urgent.

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
